Look Saver: Eyelash extensions.

The Drill: Unlike the flared or cluster lashes that have been available until now, these single extensions are bonded one at a time, to look and feel more natural. The lashes are available in either a C-curl or J-curl shape (most South Africans have eyelashes that are shaped in a C). Perming them straight can actually make the application easier

Applying the extensions may take up to two hours, but you'll be lying back in a reclining chair and may even dose off. Each lash is bonded to what therapists call "teenage" lashes – those that are not in the cycle of being shed soon – and are applied just away from the skin at the bottom of the lashes. Once complete, air is sprayed over the eyes to help the glue set. You must, however, follow the aftercare instructions diligently, and make sure you go for maintenance every two to four weeks.

The Damage: Between R450 and R800, and around R250 for maintenance.

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
